

WHO ARE WE?

Mardin Joint Women's Cooperation Association (MOKİD) was established in Mardin in March 2007 as part of the "Women's Center Project". MOKİD continues its work with the vision of a society where all forms of violence and discrimination against women end and where there is justice, equality and freedom for women and girls; to combat all forms of violence based on gender inequality with a rights-based perspective; in this context, it carries out advocacy, campaigning, research, training and lobbying activities in order to empower women and girls and ensure that they have equal opportunities.

Since its establishment, MOKİD has been conducting awareness raising trainings, seminars, conferences and group workshops on women's human rights, gender equality, prevention of violence against women, domestic communication, health, reproductive health and legal rights, providing uninterrupted social, psychological and legal counseling to women who have been subjected to violence at the Women's Counseling Center (WCC), and advocating for the prevention of violence against women and Child, Early and Forced Marriages (CEFM).

OUR VISION

To create a society of justice, equality and freedom, where all forms of violence and discrimination against women and girls end.

OUR MISSION

To combat all forms of violence based on gender inequality with a rights-based perspective; in this context, to carry out consultancy, information, advocacy, campaign, research, training and lobbying activities in order to empower women and girls and ensure that they have equal opportunities.

OUR PRINCIPLES AND VALUES

It acts on the principle of gender equality.

Autonomous: MOKID works independently of any political party, government or religious institution.

Participatory: MOKID strives for participation and uses participatory decision-making mechanisms at all levels of its work. It is open to changes and innovations within the framework of gender equality and democratic citizenship. It conducts rights-based work.

Anti-discrimination: In its work, MOKİD takes due care to respect the human rights of all and to eliminate all forms of discrimination.

Equality and justice: MOKID strives for equality and justice for all differences based on factors such as gender, age, race, religion, language, political or other opinion, class, ethnic origin, health status, disability, marital status, migrant or refugee status or any other status.

Solidarity -Collective work: MOKID is committed to working at different levels as part of an interconnected collective movement to strengthen women's spirit of struggle and increase their impact. It emphasizes solidarity, networking and connections between different groups. When necessary, it values solidarity and cooperation with different levels of the women's movement (local, regional, national, international, public institutions and organizations) as well as with other rights-based groups. Believes that the most effective change and transformation can take place in solidarity.

Idealist: MOKİD strives to come up with the best solutions that are bold, creative and raise awareness if they will make a positive contribution to society.

Transparent, accountable: MOKID adopts the principles of truthfulness, honesty, openness, transparency and accountability at every stage of its work. It ensures visibility of the use of financial resources and uses the necessary mechanisms to this end.

Without prejudice: MOKID recognizes each individual as a "human being" and approaches each individual as having value without prejudice.

Inclusive: MOKID believes in bringing together diverse groups of people (refugee, local, Turkish, Kurdish, Arab, Assyrian) to participate, advocate for diversity by supporting solidarity, consultation and production. It is inspired by knowledge and experience. Believes in the impact of an inclusive, solidarity environment where sharing and collaboration are encouraged in order to develop as individuals and as a community.

Open to learning and development: MOKİD has done and is still doing a lot of work in the past to learn, to increase its knowledge and experience, to develop its capacity and to make all these sustainable in order to expand its field of work by following innovations that will strengthen its service quality and service area. It is open to rights-based work, changes and innovations within the framework of gender equality, universal human rights and democracy.

OUR ACTIVITIES

MOKİD provides social, psychological and legal counseling support to women who apply to the Women's Counseling Center (WCC) in line with their needs. It also acts as a bridge between the relevant institutions/organizations and women by identifying the needs of women who apply to the WCC and directing them to benefit from the services provided by public institutions/organizations and NGOs operating in Mardin.

Within the scope of women's empowerment activities, in addition to training activities, it also provides literacy courses to facilitate women's participation in social life, and production workshops to facilitate women's participation in employment by providing them with vocational skills.

Since 2015, MOKİD has included refugee women in its field of work/service with the mass migration movements following the war in Syria. In this context, MOKİD carries out counseling, training and social cohesion activities to support refugee women in their struggle against violence. Social, psychological and legal counseling is provided to refugee women in their mother tongue and awareness raising activities are implemented through trainings and seminars. Within the scope of social cohesion activities, activities that bring together local and refugee women and children are carried out.

MOKİD has also targeted men in its advocacy efforts to raise social awareness within the scope of Gender Equality and Prevention of Violence against Women. In this context, since 2014, it has been conducting awareness raising activities for men on "Gender Equality", "Violence against Women" and "Mechanisms to Combat Violence", "Child and Forced Marriages".

MOKİD also trains male and female trainers who can implement training and awareness raising activities in the field through the "Training of Trainers" model. With this model, refugee and local female trainers who have reached the capacity to implement trainings organize awareness raising trainings for women and male trainers organize awareness raising trainings for men. It has also implemented the "Training of Trainers" model for university students in order to raise awareness among young people, and works to raise awareness among young people on gender equality and prevention of violence against women by ensuring that trainers provide awareness trainings for their peers.

MOKİD also carries out activities to support the social and psychological empowerment of women and to ensure women's empowerment in the economic field by removing the obstacles to their economic dependence. To this end, MOKİD pioneered the establishment of a women's cooperative in 2022. Cooperation with the Women's Solidarity and Employment Center Agricultural Development Cooperative (KADİM), established by women beneficiaries of MOKİD with the support of MOKİD, enables/will enable joint work for the economic empowerment of disadvantaged women.

Another target group of MOKİD is public institutions. Through strong collaborations with public institutions, MOKİD aims to improve the women's studies perspective of the personnel working in institutions providing services in this field, and to increase their sensitivity and awareness on the issue by organizing trainings to increase gender sensitivity for public personnel. With the trainings and meetings organized in this context, it carries out advocacy activities to mobilize anti-violence mechanisms to produce more functional and urgent solutions. At the same time, by organizing cooperation development meetings with public institutions/organizations and NGOs working in the field of women and refugees, it strengthens the communication of organizations providing services in the field and enables the development of cooperation in order for women to benefit from the services provided at the maximum level.

MOKID has become a member of the "Food Rescue Network" to contribute to ecological sustainability and a cleaner world. As a member of the Food Rescue Network, MOKID provides food support to families in need by purchasing deformed and deformed packaged food products from chain supermarkets in Mardin before their shelf life expires. In this

context, MOKID provides food support to families with low income and in need through food rescue activities.

MOKİD offers a "Children's Playroom" to enable women who receive services at the KDM to benefit more effectively from counseling and empowerment activities and to facilitate women's participation in social life by reducing their domestic responsibilities. While benefiting from MOKİD's services or participating in its activities, women leave their children aged 0-6 in the playroom, which operates under the supervision of a pre-school educator, so that they can benefit more efficiently from the activities they participate in. While their mothers benefit from the services, their children have the opportunity to spend quality time supporting their cognitive and social development through activities and educational activities simultaneously.

MOKID has been/is continuing to be the voice of women by conveying the problems experienced by women in the field and the current situation on the platforms of which it is a member, and at the same time has been/is monitoring the functionality of the relevant mechanisms. In 81 provinces, she is a member of the Provincial Coordination Board for Combating Violence against Women and the Board for the Prevention of Early and Forced Marriage of Children, established under the coordination of Provincial Directorates of Family and Social Services and governorships. She is also a member of the Refugee Council of Turkey. She has carried out and continues to carry out advocacy activities by taking an active role in the Provincial Coordination Board for Combating VAW, Provincial Coordination Board for the Prevention of Early and Forced Marriage of Children and Refugee Council of Turkey.

PROJECTS

Since its establishment, MOKİD has carried out many projects to ensure the social, psychological and economic empowerment of women and to contribute to social change by raising social awareness in line with its vision and mission.

A total of 72,992 people benefited from the activities carried out until the end of 2023 within the scope of the projects carried out with the funds provided by national and international organizations since the establishment of MOKID.

The number of women who benefited from the services provided in different fields within the scope of MOKID Women's Counseling Center (KDM) between 2019-2023 is given in the table below. In the last five (5) years, 6836 women benefited from Social Counseling Services, 528 women benefited from Psychological Counseling Services, 1016 women benefited from Legal Counseling Services and 6125 children benefited from Children's Playroom Services. The total number of women and children benefiting from Women's Counseling Center Services is 14,505.

MOKİD has implemented many programs to promote women's empowerment not only through the counseling services it provides, but also through the socialization of women and the elimination of barriers to their participation in active life. Some of these activities implemented in the last five years are as follows:

In order to contribute to the development of life skills of illiterate women, 186 women learned to read and write by implementing the Lifelong Learning Programs of the Ministry of National Education.

In order to ensure that women acquire vocational skills or improve their existing skills and become economically empowered, the Ministry of National Education implemented Vocational Skills Courses of various occupational groups from the Lifelong Learning Programs and 208 women successfully completed the programs.

Within the scope of the projects directly implemented by MOKİD, 6411 women participated in the trainings and seminars and contributed to raising their awareness.

1389 men participated in trainings on topics such as Prevention of Violence against Women, Child, Early and Forced Marriages, and Legal Rights, with the aim of raising social awareness to impact women's lives with stronger steps.

Within the scope of its projects, MOKİD has implemented a training of trainers program with different groups including women, men, university students, lawyers and personnel of the Provincial Directorate of Family and Social Services. A total of 107 people participated in train-the-trainer programs, contributing to the capacity to provide trainings.

In line with its vision and mission, MOKID aims to work for Gender Equality, Prevention of Violence against Women and Prevention of Early and Forced Marriages; to expand its service area and create opportunities to provide services to women in the districts of Mardin where there is little work in the field of women; and to contribute to the social, psychological and economic empowerment of women. As an organization that aims to touch the lives of more women with each new project and study and to carry out advocacy activities for the improvement of women's lives, it will continue to take firm steps forward on its path.
